**Announcement**

(in the pandemic COVID-19)

The Board of Directors would like to inform the investors that SIF Moldova, one of the most important players in the Romanian capital market, is constantly carrying out social responsibility activities, in accordance with its own Corporate Governance Code.

Every year, SIF Moldova and the companies belonging to the group, support directly or through specialized foundations and associations, the deprived categories from the community where the activity takes place, as well as educational, medical, scientific, cultural, sport or environmental activities and local or national events.

This year, because we understand the severity of the pandemic and its implications for public health and life, we have decided to urgently and as a priority direct our support to the hospitals involved in the fight against SARS-COV2 coronavirus to provide an additional opportunity for patients and healthcare professionals.

In this context, we supported "Cantacuzino" National Military-Medical Institute for Research and Development, Bucharest Emergency University Hospital, Clinical Hospital "Dr. Victor Babes" Bucharest, Colentina Clinical Hospital Bucharest, Bacau County Emergency Hospital, Bacau Pneumoftiziologie Hospital, Moinesti Emergency Hospital and last but not least the Royal Club of Physicians.

Thus, we bought and donated or financially supported the purchase by hospitals of medical equipment and sanitary protection materials as follows: centrifuges for specialized laboratories, non-invasive ventilators and accessories for dozens of patients, oxygen therapy devices, kits for intensive care, ATI defibrillator, pulsimeters, video laryngoscope, infrared sphygmomanometers, antiseptic sinks, specialized masks, gloves, coveralls, other consumables and COVID tests.

The total amount of sponsorships made this year is close to RON 1 million.

During this difficult period, we did not forget to help Fundatia de Sprijin Comunitar - a special program in collaboration with the Bacau County Council regarding the assistance of the elderly or the associations Total pentru un Suras and People United, which carries out activities for the benefit of the deprived children.

Given the latest decisions of the Ministry of Education, namely not to reopen schools this year, we also contribute to the financing of the Bacau County Council program to support children from rural areas to purchase tablets with internet access, in order to participate in online courses.

SIF Moldova uses the fiscal facilities in force provided by the current legislation.

SIF Moldova promotes its own values "transparency, quality, performance". We are happy that we can help and we also encourage others to do so.
