Bucharest Stock Exchange (BVB) informs that yesterday's trading session brought a record for the Structured Products market in terms of traded volume: there were traded 12,453 certificates, 5 times the average daily traded volume of the market, amounting to RON 580,734.34 (aprox. EUR 140.000) total traded value, which is 70% higher than the daily average traded value of the market.

Since its launch, the Structured Products market reached a total traded value of RON 6 mill. (aprox. EUR 1.39 mill.)

The BVB Structured Products market was launched on July 8, 2010, on it being available for trading 6 turbo certificates and 12 index certificates, issued by Erste Group Bank AG and Raiffeisen Centrobank AG. Both banks act like liquidity provider for their own listed products.
