Aquila Part Prod Com S.A. informs its shareholders and investors regarding the expansion of its operational capacity in Eastern Romania.

AQUILA is expanding its operational capacity in Eastern Romania by optimizing operations in a new logistics center in Bacău County

Ploiesti, May 21st, 2026: AQUILA (symbol [AQ](#)), leader in integrated distribution and logistics services for the fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG) market in Romania and the region, with over 30 years of experience in this industry, has inaugurated its new logistics center in Bacău, a strategic project in which the company invested over EUR 1.2 million. The new center strengthens AQUILA's presence in Eastern Romania and supports the expansion of its operational capacities.

The new logistics infrastructure integrates the relocated operations into a modern facility with expanded capacity and optimized features designed to improve operational flows and accelerate distribution.

*“The accelerated expansion of the AQUILA Group and the integration of the acquired companies support the development of a modern distribution and logistics hub in Bacău, a strategic center aimed at strengthening our operations in the Eastern region. The facility is designed to handle multiple temperature categories, both for ambient and frozen products. AQUILA already operates distribution centers in Iași, Suceava, and Chișinău, Republic of Moldova, as well as at Romtec-Europa in Iași, where **JetXpert** products are manufactured, AQUILA's domestic brand in the automotive maintenance and car care category. The new location provides us with a premium quality space, with storage and operational areas more than twice as large as those used previously. By exponentially increasing our operational capacity, we are creating the conditions to manage larger volumes, optimize logistics flows, and increase the flexibility of the services offered to our partners and customers.”*



The new AQUILA logistics center is strategically located in the southern area of Bacău, within ELI Park, with quick access to the main national and international transport routes, especially to the new road infrastructure currently under continuous development. The center has a total area of approximately 9,000 sqm, including warehouse and office spaces, and a total capacity of around 7,400 pallets. It is operated under a long term commitment. The infrastructure is designed to support multiple temperature categories, both for ambient and frozen products, and integrates modern facilities dedicated to optimizing logistics flows. The location is equipped with 15 truck docks with hydraulic ramps, drive in access, and advanced temperature control systems tailored to the specific requirements of each product category.

Operations are digitalized through the WMS D365 system, including projects dedicated to the modern retail segment. The infrastructure also includes modern equipment powered by Li-ion batteries, a 250 kW generator, a fire detection system, and facilities dedicated to employees. In line with the Group's sustainability objectives, the building holds a Class B energy certification, uses LED lighting for both indoor and outdoor areas, and utilizes CO₂ as a cooling agent for the frozen products area. In addition, the installation of photovoltaic panels is planned for 2028.

Within its logistics business line, AQUILA provides efficient and customized services through warehousing, repackaging, and domestic transportation operations for food and non food products across multiple temperature categories, ambient, refrigerated, and frozen, complementing its fast moving consumer goods distribution activities.

About AQUILA

AQUILA is one of the largest players in the fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG) distribution sector from Romania and the region, operating an integrated business model that covers distribution, logistics, and transportation across multiple temperature categories, for both food and non-food products, as well as production activities.

With an expanded presence in Moldova and Hungary, the company provides efficient and customized solutions, helping partners optimize their supply chain. Through modern infrastructure and an extensive network across three countries, AQUILA ensures the availability of a wide range of products in over **78,000 points of sale**, including traditional stores, modern retail chains, and online platforms. AQUILA's portfolio of over **22,000 products** includes both own brands, such as **Gradena, LaMasă,** and **JetXpert**, as well as globally recognized brands like **Kinder, Lavazza, Whiskas,** and **Mutti**. Through the four recent acquisitions, the company has strengthened its position in the regional market, offering customers an extended selection of products, including consumer goods, car maintenance solutions, and health and safety equipment. AQUILA operates through four main distribution channels, with a strategic focus on developing the HoReCa segment by leveraging a complementary portfolio and synergies with acquired companies. The company also owns the largest and most efficient distribution fleet in the region, consisting of over 1,600 vehicles, including more than 300 trucks.



In 2025, AQUILA recorded record revenues of approximately RON 3.5 billion, up 18% compared to the previous year, supported by its growth strategy focused on strengthening the distribution segment, diversifying the portfolio, and developing own brands.

Founded in 1994 by entrepreneurs Alin Adrian Dociu and Constantin Cătălin Vasile, AQUILA was listed on the Bucharest Stock Exchange (BVB) in November 2021. The AQUILA Group includes six companies: AQUILA Part Prod Com SA (parent company) and its subsidiaries PRINTEX SA, Trigor AVD SRL (from the Republic of Moldova), Romtec Europa SRL, Parmafood Group Distribution SRL, Parmafood Trading SRL, and KITAX Kft from Hungary.

AQUILA's shares ([AQ](#)) are included in the Bucharest Stock Exchange reference index – BET and in the MSCI Frontier and MSCI Romania indices. Over the past two years, the share price increased by more than 20% per year, outperforming the market.

With over 3,600 employees, including 5% of international staff, AQUILA promotes an organizational culture based on diversity and inclusion. The company is committed to creating long-term value for investors, employees, and communities, integrating ESG principles into its business strategy. Through sustainable initiatives, transparency demonstrated by the highest VEKTOR by ARIR score of 10, and operational efficiency, AQUILA fosters an inclusive work environment and maintains a strong commitment to the communities in which it operates. For its ESG performance, the company was awarded the EcoVadis Silver Medal in 2025.
