



MedLife expands access to integrated medical services with a new hyperclinic in Bucharest

- *MedLife's newest hyperclinic is located in Bucharest's District 5 and is the result of an investment of more than EUR 1 million.*

Bucharest, July 2, 2026 – MedLife, Romania's largest private healthcare network, announces the opening of a new hyperclinic in Bucharest following an investment of more than EUR 1 million. Located at 40 Panduri Road, District 5, the new facility provides patients with access to integrated medical services, including laboratory testing, specialist consultations, and functional monitoring. In addition, the newly opened unit has incorporated the operations of the former MedLife Panduri clinic, which previously served patients in the area.

With this opening, MedLife now operates 37 hyperclinics nationwide, including eight in Bucharest, further strengthening its position as the leader in Romania's private healthcare market.

"The opening of a new large-scale facility in Bucharest is a natural step in our development strategy and responds to patients' growing need for access to a comprehensive portfolio of medical services closer to home. Through our network of hyperclinics across the capital, we are now able to be even closer to our patients and provide fast access to integrated healthcare services, regardless of where they are located. The new hyperclinic has been developed according to the one-stop-shop model, offering convenient access to a wide range of medical specialties, laboratory testing, and advanced technologies," said Dorin Preda, Deputy Chief Executive Officer, MedLife Group.

The MedLife Panduri Hyperclinic spans approximately 1,000 square meters across three floors and features 16 consultation rooms, a minor procedures room, and a dedicated sample collection unit for laboratory testing. Patients have access to 27 medical specialties, including obstetrics and gynaecology, internal medicine, rheumatology, diabetes and nutrition, neurology, cardiology, endocrinology, oncology, nephrology, and many others. The diagnostic services are supported by modern medical technology and multidisciplinary teams with both national and international expertise.

By integrating services available on both a fee-for-service basis and through corporate healthcare subscription plans, the new hyperclinic expands access to comprehensive medical care for residents of Bucharest and the surrounding areas.

Through this investment, MedLife further strengthens its presence in Bucharest while continuing the expansion of its national network, which now comprises 37 hyperclinics. The Group introduced the hyperclinic concept to describe large-scale medical facilities that provide patients with a one-stop-shop healthcare experience—from laboratory testing and specialist consultations to diagnostic investigations and functional monitoring—ensuring comprehensive medical care in a single location.
